

The United States "Citizenship, Involvement, Democracy" (CID) Survey

The U.S. CID Survey was conducted in May-July 2005 with a nationally representative sample of Americans, using in-person interviews. These tables provide basic findings on some of the questions from the survey—organized by theme—with the overall results as well as breakdowns by gender, education, age group, and ethnicity/race.
