

2010 CHECKLIST

Pay deposit of \$500. The Registrar will send your NetID. Use the Net ID to secure an e-mail address. Join smp10@yahoogroup.com and look for announcements.

Billing: There will be a new billing system this year. You will be able to arrange a payment cycle online. Please contact the Student Account Office for all billing concerns (<http://studentaccounts@georgetown.edu>), but note that you should receive a bill prior to orientation.

Registration: Ms. Cabiness will register you for classes at orientation.

GoCard: Send a picture and the gocard online form via e-mail to the GOCARD Office to avoid lines at orientation or mail the paper form from the Grad school packet and e-mail a picture. Your GoCard must be picked up in person with proper ID. See the website for information: <http://gocard.georgetown.edu>.

Student Health: Send in immunization and tuberculosis report to Student Health. Bring proof of health insurance to orientation or you will have to pay for insurance. Forms can be found on the following website: <http://shc.georgetown.edu>.

Find Housing: There is no housing on campus. We do have an Off Campus Housing Office. They may be of assistance. Any available housing that is reported to our office is posted on the yahoo group listserve.

Mailbox Key & Notetaking Service: You will be assigned a mailbox, no charge. Bring additional money for Notetaking Service (\$250-\$300). This is not mandatory, but most students subscribe. You will be assigned a locker with one locker mate (no cost). For your classes you will receive an iclicker, which you will return at the end of the year – if it is not returned your account will be charged \$25.

Books: Bring no less than \$500 for books, but listen to big brothers and sisters before buying the books.

Letters of Recommendation: You must use your undergraduate letters of recommendation for medical school applications. The Director will send a letter of notification to your schools to let them know that you are in the program. Your advisor will send a letter with late fall grades of completed classes. This will not replace the undergraduate letters. Please furnish address labels to Ms. Cabiness for the schools that will not be included on the AMCAS mailing list (this list is on SMP website under accepted students). You do not have to furnish the envelopes.

We follow the first year medical school schedule for attendance. We follow the Graduate School schedule for tuition payments.

If planning flights out of D.C. make sure to allow at least 4 hours after the end of class.
